

Final Conference Information

Programmes and Sessions

The website has now been updated with all of the new conference programmes.

Conference Audio Visual

Each conference room will contain a computer/ laptop (loaded with Microsoft Power Point), an LCD (data) projector and an over head projector. Delegates who are giving presentations are advised to go to their sessions 10 – 20 minutes early to load their presentations onto the in-room computer. It is also advised to bring your presentation on more than one format, pen drives being the most preferred method.

Conference Location

The conference will be held at both Glasgow Caledonian University and Strathclyde University campuses. These are located in the city centre of Glasgow, which is served by 2 Airports, Glasgow International and Prestwick. These airports are between 20 – 45 minutes away from Glasgow. The main train stations are Glasgow Central Station and Queen Street Station, both are within 10 minutes walk of the conference. The main bus station, Buchanan Bus Station, is directly in front of the main university building. While there are no car parking facilities available to delegates at the university, there is a large car park, Concert Square, directly opposite the university.

Conference Registration

Registration for the conference will take place at the Hamish Wood Building Refectory at Glasgow Caledonian University and will open on Monday the 3rd at 10am until 6pm, Tuesday 4th 8am – 5pm, Wednesday 5th 8am – 6pm and Thursday 6th 8am – 1.30pm.

All delegates are asked to register at the conference desks prior to attending sessions, to ensure they receive all of the relevant information and conference materials. We would also ask that all delegates wear their badges when on either campus due to new security measures in place in Scotland.

Travel Passes

Free travel passes will be available at both Glasgow International and Prestwick Airports on Sunday the 2nd and Monday the 3rd of September. These passes can be used for all rail, bus, subway and ferry travel within the Glasgow area and cover travel to and from the airports. There are valid from Sunday the 2nd until Thursday the 6th. Passes will be available from the ESA Conference stand in the arrivals hall at Prestwick Airport from 10am – 11pm on Sunday 2nd and Monday 3rd and the SPT desk at Glasgow Airport from 9am – 8pm on Sunday 2nd and 8am – 8pm on Monday 3rd. Passes will also be available at the registration desks for the length of the conference. Please note the travel passes can only be given registered delegates. For those bringing partners etc we may be able to sell a small number of passes at the conference if these are still available at the time (we cannot sell passes at either airports, so please do not ask).
